- The meeting was called to order by Billy Lumpkin at the Lottie & Arthur Temple Civic Center, Diboll, Texas on 2.22.20 @ 5:10pm.
- The following directors were present: Billy Lumpkin, RA Wall, John Ippolito & Jill Berry.
- Committee members present were: Steve Clarady, Danelle Brashear, Glenn Hammond & Eliza Harty.
- Steve Clarady led us in prayer.
- Billy Lumpkin ascertained a quorum was present with 158 members & 15 guests in attendance.
- The minutes of the 66th annual meeting (held 2.23.19) were read and approved.
- Billy Lumpkin thanked the members for coming, discussed the current condition of the credit union, thanked fellow board members, committee members & employees.
- Carla Kelley welcomed everyone.
- Steve Clarady, Chairman of the Audit Committee, presented the annual audit report.
